Southern Teachers is assisting Boys' Latin as it seeks an Assistant Head of Upper School, a new position at BL, to be responsible for oversight of the US student body, including academic and disciplinary procedures, character development, and programming that focuses on personal development. Reporting to and partnering with the Head of the Upper School, the Assistant Head sets the tone for the community and works collaboratively with faculty, students, and families.

Candidates must have an appreciation for single-sex education and understand the needs of boys and best practices to engage students in the life of the school. They should hold advanced degrees and have at least five years teaching experience in independent schools. Candidates with administrative experience are preferred.

Boys' Latin is the oldest independent and nonsectarian college preparatory school for boys in Maryland, currently serving 615 students in kindergarten through grade twelve, with an Upper School enrollment of 300. The school is accredited by the Association of Independent Maryland & DC Schools (AIMS). Affiliations include the International Boys' Schools Coalition (IBSC) and the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS).

Boys' Latin offers a rigorous academic program that prepares young men for the challenges of the 21st century. The school's motto, *Esse Quam Videri*, "To Be Rather Than To Seem," emphasizes the development of one's integrity, courage, and compassion for others and has been the core value of a Boys' Latin education since 1844. Boys' Latin welcomes young men from diverse backgrounds and educates them in a supportive, student-centered environment. A low student-teacher ratio fosters positive relationships, thereby challenging each student to reach his maximum potential while empowering him to mature with an increasing sense of self-worth and an awareness of his responsibilities toward himself and his community.
