Southern Teachers Agency is assisting the South Carolina Governor's School for the Arts and Humanities (SCGSAH) in the search for their next Director of Enrollment and Outreach. The Director of Enrollment and Outreach will direct and coordinate the recruitment of talented South Carolina high school students for enrollment in the summer and residential programs at SCGSAH. Related duties include supervising selected outreach activities and working closely with personnel in the area of service learning, public information, and student orientation as well as coordinating recruitment activities with the faculty of all five art areas.

The Director must have strong interpersonal, written, and oral communication skills with the ability to present the mission of the school clearly and persuasively to students and parents. A commitment to diversity is required. The ability to collect, analyze, and use appropriate data is necessary. Experience recruiting students for enrollment in college or high school is preferred. A minimum of a bachelor's degree is required. Limited overnight travel is expected and the Director reports to the President. The faculty and staff of the school are employees of the state of South Carolina.

The South Carolina Governor's School for the Arts and Humanities is highly selective. All students must be from South Carolina and successfully complete an audition for admission to either the summer programs or the residential high school. The high school is recognized nationally for the excellence of both its academic and arts programs. All faculty members have advanced degrees and/or significant professional reputations. There is a tuition charge for the summer programs, but the residential high school charges no tuition or room fees and the cost of the meal plan can be defrayed by a generous scholarship program. No student is denied admission due to the lack of financial resources. There is a maximum of 242 students in the residential high school.

The school is located in the vibrant downtown of Greenville, SC, with easy access to galleries, theatres, and museums. The population of the metropolitan area is over 500,000 and the location offers extensive outdoor recreation. The Governor's School for the Arts and Humanities is a unique institution committed to the highest level of excellence.
