Founded in 2000, Trinity Episcopal School is an independent coeducational school of 415 children in grades kindergarten through eight. Situated on an attractive urban campus in the Garden District of Charlotte's First Ward neighborhood, Trinity capitalizes upon the vibrant Center City as an extended classroom for cultural enrichment, hands-on learning, and opportunities to serve the community.

A profoundly mission-driven institution, Trinity is dedicated to three equally valued and thoroughly intertwined goals: *creating scholars*, *nurturing spirituality*, and *embracing diversity*. Trinity is a place of pride and passion, where teachers and students are fully engaged. Trinity's constructivist curriculum challenges students to academic excellence and seeks to maintain the curiosity natural to kindergarteners. In keeping with the Episcopal educational tradition, spiritual development is integral to the Trinity experience, reflected in regular opportunities for community worship and a comprehensive service-learning program. The founders of Trinity Episcopal School sought to create a student body that would reflect the population of the Charlotte metropolitan area. Trinity is home to a rich variety of people from diverse racial, ethnic, religious, and socioeconomic backgrounds. This intentional pluralism is a hallmark of Episcopal schools. Trinity has also established an honor code that holds students to the highest standards of integrity and personal conduct.

The Head of Middle School is a member of the senior administrative team and reports directly to the Head of School. The Head of Middle School is expected to understand and promote the mission, standards, and policies of Trinity Episcopal. The Head of Middle School provides leadership for and support in the division to students, faculty, and parents.

Trinity seeks candidates with at least ten years of experience in education, including at least seven years in the classroom as well as a master's degree in an academic area or in education. The best candidates will also possess the ability to provide a vision for the division, the ability to communicate that vision, the organizational and planning skills to carry out the vision and other initiatives of the school, and the critical thinking and analytical skills necessary to succeed as a leader. They should be strong communicators and enjoy being an effective member of an administrative team. Finally, they should have the ability to work with and/or motivate a wide range of people including students, faculty, administration, and parents.
